Nominating Petition

- Candidate's name and the officer position that candidate is running for must be printed at the top.
- Officer positions for which the candidate is running (choose <u>one</u> from the following):
 President-Elect (PE), Vice President (VP) Collective Bargaining, Vice President (VP) Supervisory,
 Vice President (VP) At Large, Secretary, Treasurer, and Membership Secretary.
- Must have printed name, signature, and date from at least 10 Sacramento Section members who sign the Nominating Petition for the candidate. Make sure that members write legibly because it's required that each person who signs the candidate's Nominating Petition be verified as a current PECG Sacramento Section member (if candidate has any doubt, then get 11 or 12 signatures from members to be certain at least 10 are valid).
- At the end of the Nominating Petition, the candidate must print & sign their name, then date it.
